

KICKSTART! Completion

What Next??

CONGRATS! You have now completed and passed your Kickstart and are almost ready to start riding with us!

Just one more step to complete and that's to get your riding licence from Motorcycling NSW (MNSW).

You will have received your KICKSTART Book from one of our coaches on completion of Kickstart, this is a very important book as it has your Kickstart signed off in the back to enable you to apply for your MNSW Riding Licence. You will need to scan and save these pages to upload to Ridernet later on. You also need to scan and save your child's ID (birth certificate or passport) as MNSW have to verify your child's age.

*Note: it is a requirement of MNSW that all licenced riders have NSW Ambulance cover as a minimum, this is normally covered under your private health insurance if you have it, if no private health insurance you will need to apply for an Ambulance only policy via a health fund – ie NIB have a policy for approx \$50p.a. If you are injured at the track ambulance costs are **NOT** covered by MNSW or the club. You will need your policy details to enter into Ridernet during the licence application process.*

LICENCES

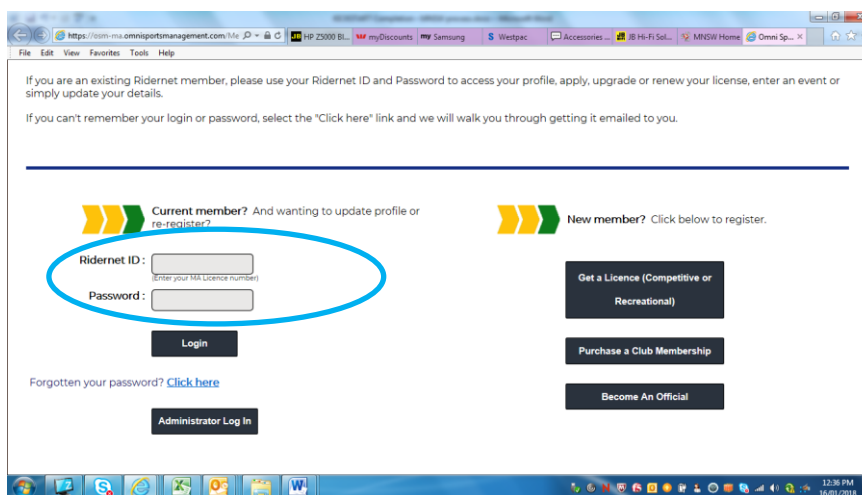
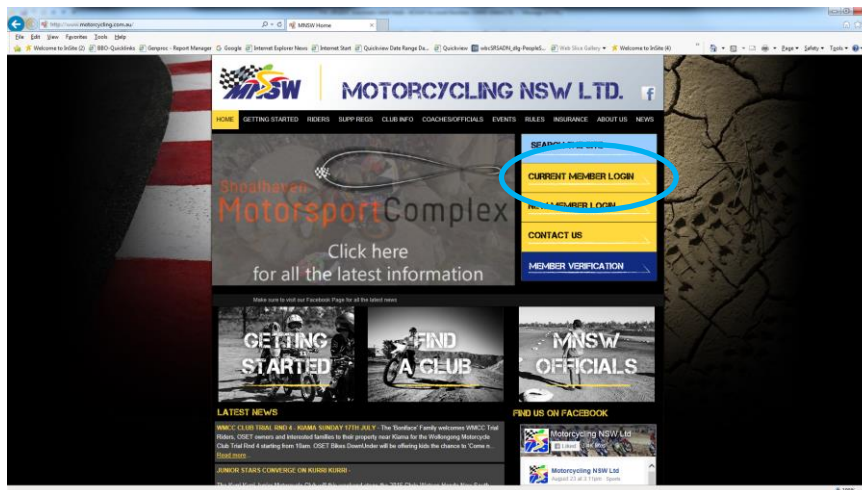
There are **2 Licence types** available to you, please be very careful to select the correct one that suits you and your riding needs.

The 2 are;

1. **MINI Licence (mini)** - deemed Non-Competitive by Motorcycling NSW current cost \$130 per year – this licence only allows you to ride and compete at Minikhana events Only (Club, Interclub and State Titles Minikhana – NO Motocross or any Competitive events in other disciplines. A Mini Licence is restricted to Minikhana events ONLY which are usually held at Minikhana Clubs).
2. **JUNIOR NATIONAL Licence (JNA)** - deemed competitive by MNSW current cost \$299.00 this licence allows you to participate at Competition events in Motocross, Minikhana events and other disciplines at a Competitive level throughout the NSW Motorcycle Clubs. As this is a 'National Licence' it is recognised Australia wide. When competing away from your home Club (at a Club where you are not a member), please be advised that it is usually a requirement to purchase a Club membership or a Club DAY membership.

Below are the instructions to apply for your licence. We would have already completed your membership and above is your Ridernet number which you use to log on to Ridernet to process your licence.

1. Go to MNSW website www.motorcycling.com.au
2. From home page select "Current Member Login" (pic below) you should have also received a email from OnniSports confirming your login details – if you haven't received this email, refer above for Ridernet ID and select '*forgotten Password*' to set up your password. **Do not select 'New Member'**.



3. Once Logged in - Select 'My Licence' from the tabs across the Top Line
 4. Apply for 'Annual Licence'
 5. Select Licence Type – Competitive (Minikhana and other disciplines) or Non Competitive (Minikhana Only)
 6. Complete Ambulance Cover Details
 7. Complete preferred Discipline – Minikhana and any other preferences
 8. Select Licence Type - Junior National Competition Licence or Mini Licence
- NOTE please select the correct option - "Junior National Competition" please don't select "Junior Restricted" you will not be able to ride Minikhana on this licence and will involve you having to contact MNSW to correct and unable to ride till corrected, Yes a Junior National is more expensive than a Restricted the cost is \$299 p.a*
9. Complete club information
 - a. Choose Blacktown Junior Mini Bike Club in the dropdown box
 10. Proof of Identity – upload your proof of Identity here. This will need to be a scanned copy or a clear photo of your Childs birth certificate or passport.
 11. Add any other family members who have a current licence (if needed) to enable family discount. You will need to upload a copy of your Medicare card where all family members must be named on the same card to enable the discount.
 12. Purchase of Riding Numbers is not required for Blacktown Junior Mini Bike Club please click continue (Please contact club to obtain a number if you haven't already received one)
 13. Request Endorsement for Licence (you will need to refer to your Kickstart Coaching Book for the information and scan or take a picture of your Kickstart book of where the coaches completed and signed off your Kickstart + Test and Answers ready to upload to Ridernet). You will need to upload pages 24 through to 28.
 - a. Select Bike size you completed Kickstart on – refer to top of this document or Log book
 - b. Input required information

- i. Coach
- ii. Permit number
- iii. Completion date
- iv. Please ensure information matches MNSW will check it back to the permit issued and if not matching they will reject your application.
- v. Upload Scanned Pages of your Kickstart Book you will need All pages including Test and Answer Pages
- vi. Click Submit

14. Process payment via Credit/Debit Card

15. Your licence will now pend till Motorcycling NSW verifies ID and Kickstart documents

16. Shortly after MNSW complete verification of your application - You will receive an email that it is complete. Your child will not be able to participate until they have received their Licence Card and Logbook via mail from Motorcycling NSW.

17. You can now start riding with us! Check our Calendar!

NOTES

- Your Kickstart test and documentation is only valid for 1 year from the completion date. If you have not applied for a licence within 1 year of the Kickstart competition, it will no longer be valid and you will need to re do and start again.
- Children aged 4 years to 6 years DO NOT require a logbook
- Children aged 7 years to 15 years **DO** require a logbook
- Your Ridernet number is also your Licence Number!
